Unprecedented Trans-Tasman collaboration yields first-ever PMA Fresh Connections in New Zealand

- Australasian fresh produce Conference and Trade Show to create business-building hub of up to 1000 fresh produce buyers and sellers from around the globe in Auckland this June -

The Australian fresh produce industry will have an unprecedented opportunity to network, learn, and build business in June 2014, thanks to a Trans-Tasman collaboration to bring PMA Fresh Connections, the premier conference and trade show for the fresh fruit, vegetable, and floral supply chains in the Australasian region, to New Zealand for the first time.

With the fresh produce industry worth over \$4bn annually to the NZ economy, and the export of fruit and vegetables their fourth largest export earner, the event is expected to create a global business-building hub of up to 1000 fresh produce buyers and sellers and 60+ exhibitors from Australia, New Zealand, the Pacific Rim, and around the globe.

Michael Worthington, CEO of the Produce Marketing Association Australia-New Zealand (PMA A-NZ) says that collaborating to create a global event in the Australasian region is a win-win for members of the Australian and New Zealand industries.

"This event provides the perfect opportunity for businesses across the entire Australian and New Zealand value chain to get together on major issues common to all, and to further the trade opportunities not only across the Tasman but also across the whole Pacific Rim" he said.

"Further, it's a unique opportunity for the global industry - especially buyers and sellers of a wide range of products and services from throughout the Pacific Rim - to congregate and develop trade and business connections, not only with these two countries but also with other Rim countries."

"It just makes so much sense for the industries to get together with one big event at a world-class venue, rather than having a number of smaller events" he added.

Held annually in Australia, PMA A-NZ and The Australian Chamber of Fruit and Vegetable Wholesalers (Australian Chamber) have been the successful partnership behind PMA Fresh Connections since 2011, and have joined forces with Horticulture New Zealand (HortNZ) and

United Fresh (UF) in New Zealand in 2014 to bring the event to the Viaduct Convention Centre, 24-26 June.

Shane Schnitzler, President of The Australian Chamber, believes that holding PMA Fresh Connections in New Zealand will be an advantage to central market members and the wider industry, by giving them the opportunity to take time out to work on their businesses.
